Cleanup Week (Self Reporting): Saturday, July 15th, to Sunday July 23rd, 2023.

Event Highlights!

- This event is produced by the Marine Industries Association of the Treasure Coast with grant money from the Florida Inland Navigation District.
- 1,181 volunteers participated in 2022
- 2022, we removed 3.9 tons of trash
- Since 2008: 13,400+ volunteers & 3,000 boats participated to remove more than 99 tons of trash
- This event is for people of all ages.
- Volunteers report to one of 25 registration sites in Martin, St. Lucie and Indian River Counties. We will cover approximately 125 miles of waterways.
- **Self-reporting option during cleanup week** allows volunteers & boaters the opportunity to go out and cleanup anytime. It is simple:
 - ★ Register online
 - Y Pick up trash anywhere you choose during **cleanup Week**
 - ★ Record your data using the digital data collection link
 - \star Volunteers are encouraged to cleanup multiple times during the week
- Volunteers receive an event t-shirt.
- Watercraft will receive a commemorative burgee (aka pennant)
- Excellent way for students to log community service hours
- Divers can participate in our Peck Lake Reef Dive Cleanup in Martin County that morning (see promotional flyer)
- Volunteer Raffle, when you submit your data collection information, you will be automatically entered into a raffle with all kinds of prizes from restaurant gift certificates, event tickets, nautical and marine supplies and more. Data must be entered by July 31st and the drawing will be held via Facebook Live, the 1st week in August. Date & time to be announced!
